The flawless reinvention of this 1880s terrace reveals a perfect synergy of period grandeur and high-end design over three luxurious levels. Rebuilt from the ground up with utmost respect for its heritage, the architect-redesign saw the restoration of its elegant Victorian Italianate facade with a sympathetic interior scheme that allows the home's original period features to shine.

Part of a landmark row named after South Coast Towns, Nowra is set opposite Moore Park on a dual access 139sqm. Marble fireplaces, stained glass windows and soaring ceilings serve as a gracious nod to the past while custom interiors deliver a new expression of inner city living crafted for the urbanite.

In a fashionable village precinct with a bohemian energy that serves as a magnet for emerging and established designers, this inner-city pocket is a creative hotbed where galleries, design stores and cafes define the urban landscape.
